Diploma

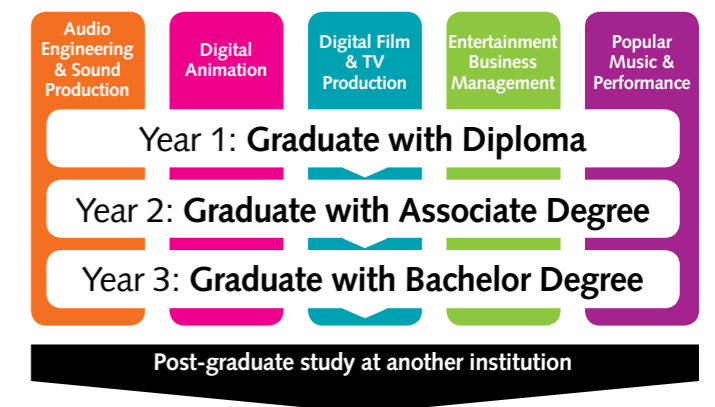
Based on full time status, students complete the programme in two semesters or one Academic Year.

Associate Degree

Based on full time status, students complete the programme in four semesters or two Academic Years.

Bachelor Degree

Based on full time status, students complete the programme in six semesters or three Academic Years.

Digital Media, Games and 3D Animation

Course Benefits

- The JMC Academy's Digital Media, Games and 3D Animation courses are at the leading edge of entertainment technology education and training.

Digital Film and Television Production

Course Benefits

- This hands-on course aims to provide students with comprehensive knowledge, and the advanced skills necessary in the creation and production of short films, television commercials, live broadcasts, documentaries and music video clips.
- This course includes an overview of the increase in specialty channels, interactive television, reality-based and 'live' television broadcasting, digital convergence, educational content production, digital publishing and the growth in distribution mediums such as broadband, mobile phone and podcasts. Students are shown how this has led to a surge in the demand for all areas of content creation, management and production.
- Students are given extensive theoretical and practical training using the most up-to-date facilities available to ensure they enter the industry with a realistic and competitive approach to all aspects of digital production.
- In this course students will be required to produce a music video project by collaborating with JMC Academy students from other departments to ensure they gain a genuine understanding of the series of networks and processes required for the project's success. As such, they may turn to Entertainment Business Management students for promotion and marketing direction, and to Popular Music Performance students for the talent provision.
- Further subjects focus on screenwriting, the exploration of television series and serials, miniseries, feature films and web based modes of delivery. Students will also be required to run a live outside broadcast for the annual JMC Academy Student Awards Showcase.

- By third year, students embark on the pre-production, development, casting, design, delivery, marketing and distribution of a television pilot, long form documentary or film production.

Entertainment Business Management

Course Benefits

- Students are given a comprehensive overview into the worldwide growth in accessibility, quantity, quality and production of popular music and events and how this has impacted upon the demand for commercially astute and confident managers.
- This course reflects the increasing shift away from 'hard copy' (CDs and DVDs) towards an increase in electronic transfers, impacting upon the need for graduates to become skilled in databasing and web buyer analysis.
- Students work towards building sound business skills within the context of the music and entertainment field. So comprehensive are the business practices taught within these courses, they may be applied to the successful running of any business.
- Students are provided with a solid grounding in the fundamentals of commerce, copyright, accounting, economics, marketing, and law.
- Additional modules include artist development, the preparation and negotiation of contracts, the organisation of rehearsals and recording schedules, the coordination of budgets, and the development of publicity and public relations.
- Throughout the course students are required to 'manage' artists from the popular music and performance course through the production of press releases, video clips, contracts and event booking schedules. This ensures students are able to exercise practical application of their skills.

- Students are encouraged to explore their creative talents through song writing, musical arrangement, improvisation and performance for stage, screen and studio.
- Students also receive extensive training in their chosen instrument and benefit from a practical mixture of band sessions, performance training sessions and movement classes.
- This course includes modules in multimedia, communication studies and the application of the internet for the music industry.

Accommodation and Living Expenses

The cost of living in Sydney, Melbourne and Brisbane depends largely on the students' lifestyle, choice of accommodation and social expenses. As a general guide, an average student could expect to spend an average of \$AUD350 per week on rent, food, and public transport. This does not allow for entertainment, study, private transport, utilities, or clothing. These items should be considered as an additional variable cost.

Whilst accommodation is not available on campus, our International Services staff are able to suggest suitable accommodation location services within reasonable proximity to each campus. Further information regarding these services is available at www.studyinaustralia.gov.au.

Working in Australia

Many JMC Academy students work to support their studies or to supplement income from home. The Australian government allows international students to be employed for up to 20 hours per week subject to obtaining a work permit. Applicants granted a student visa are now eligible to receive a work permit. Further information is available at www.immi.gov.au.

Health Cover

Students are required to obtain health cover for themselves and/or family members and are required to pay the Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) at the time of enrollment. The OSHC provides hospital and medical insurance. The JMC Academy's key provider is the International AHM (Australian Health Management). Our Locations

About Sydney

Sydney is a vibrant city nestled within the shores of spectacular Sydney Harbour at the foot of the famous Sydney Harbour Bridge. Sydney has a beautiful coastline, and most of Sydney's beaches are within 30 minutes from the city centre by public transport.

Sydney's entertainment and creative industries have earned the city international recognition as an ideal filming location. It has contributed to the success of productions such as the epic Superman Returns, The Matrix, Moulin Rouge, Happy Feet and Australia. Sydney is also home to major production houses and entertainment venues including Fox Studios, ACER Arena, Entertainment Quarter and the Entertainment Centre.

The temperature in Sydney averages a warm 23°C / 73°F (with temperatures reaching the high 30°C / mid 90°F in Summer and 13°C / 55°F in Winter). Sydney is bathed in sunshine for around 342 days of the year.

About Melbourne

Melbourne is one of the world's most multicultural cities, with one quarter of its population born overseas. With a thriving arts scene, beautiful parks and gardens, easy-to-navigate city centre and over 2,300 restaurants, bistros and cafes, Melbourne is consistently ranked in the Top 10 World's Most Livable Cities.

Melbourne loves fashion, the arts and sports! It is considered Australia's shopping capital. Its arts precinct features world-class galleries, museums, theatres and concert halls, but close by are also excellent sporting facilities and stadiums. Melbourne is home to the Australian F1 Grand Prix, Australian Tennis Open and Australian Masters Tournament.

The weather in Melbourne has a reputation for providing 'four seasons in one day'. Summer months (December to February) can vary in temperature between 25°C / 77°F, with Winter (June to September) averaging 12°C / 54°F to 19°C / 66°F.

About Brisbane

Brisbane is a rapidly growing diverse and creative city with a wealth of artistic, creative, leisure and sporting activities on offer. It is surrounded by stunning natural features including the islands of Moreton Bay, the Gold and Sunshine Coasts, and mountains and bushland.

Through the development of various initiatives such as the 'Fortitude Valley Special Entertainment Precinct' and the South Brisbane 'Creative Industries Precinct', the city is fast becoming a haven for creative students and entrepreneurs, new migrants and artists from around the world.

Brisbane has a hot, humid climate. As the capital city of Queensland, 'The Sunshine State', the average summer temperature is 30°C / 86°F, but there are many days where the temperature gets higher. Winters are mild with an average temperature of around 15°C / 59°F.

Application and Entry



Entry Requirements

International students must meet JMC Academy's admission criteria and Australia's international student requirements. These include:

- Proof of English proficiency: minimum IELTS 6.0 or equivalent.
- Evidence of successful completion of a senior Secondary School certificate (transcripts and certificate must be translated and certified).
- 200 word statement outlining why you want to study at the JMC Academy and what your career goals are. Applicants must attend an interview in person or over the phone with a member of the International Services or Student Recruitment and Admissions team.
- Overseas Student Health Cover must be purchased for the duration of studies. The JMC Academy can purchase this on students' behalf.
- Applicants must be at least 17 years of age on commencement of studies. Applicants under the age of 18 must have a legal guardian in Australia. In some cases JMC can assist in making suitable welfare arrangements.
- Popular Music and Performance applicants must undertake an audition. Students are required to perform two contrasting pieces of music of their own choice. The two pieces should not exceed ten minutes total. Audition videos/online links are accepted for applicants living overseas or interstate.
- Digital Media, Games and 3D Animation students are required to prepare a portfolio of sample work/drawings.
- Payment of AUD150 registration fee.
- Applications will be accepted until 2 weeks before the course commences, but please note that visa applications can take a few months. Please contact the Australian Embassy in your home country for recommended timeframes to lodge your visa application.

Requirements for Alternative Admission

A conditional entry to a one-year Diploma (articulating into a Bachelor Degree) is based on:

- Written application (with compulsory 200 word statement to ascertain functional literacy)
- An interview to identify potential difficulties that may impact on learning.
- Demonstrated commitment with satisfactory communication skills sufficient to indicate reasonable likelihood of successful completion of Diploma studies.
- Applicants must be 17 years or older on commencement of studies.
- Applicants must show evidence of minimum completion Year 10 or equivalent with prior VET qualification and/or relevant industry work experience.
- A suitable portfolio of work or performance audition.
- Demonstrated (above average) creative aptitude or expertise pertinent to field of interest.

Intakes

1. All levels of study normally commence at the beginning of March.
2. JMC Academy offers a mid-year "Fast Track" intake for 1st Year students, conditional upon minimum enrolment numbers. Check with us for details of which courses are expected to be delivered at each campus. Fast Track programs run from late June to the beginning of March.

Student Visas

Whilst JMC Academy staff are able to guide you regarding student visa information, we strongly suggest all international applicants contact the Australian diplomatic mission in your country or one of JMC's agent representatives.

Recognition of Prior Learning

- Students may be given Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or recognition of skills gained in similar courses.
- If you believe that you are eligible for RPL for any unit of your course, please advise the JMC Academy at the time of your interview.
- The JMC Academy requires all original academic transcripts, or certified copies from the student's previous institution as well as a course breakdown of all previous studies. Fees may apply for RPL assessment.

ESOS Framework – Education Services for Overseas Students

The Australian Government wants overseas students in Australia to have a safe, enjoyable and rewarding place to study. Australia's laws promote quality education and consumer protection for overseas students. These laws are known as the ESOS framework and they include the Education Services for Overseas (ESOS) Act 2000 and the National Code.

International Qualification Equivalents

JMC Academy programmes are open to all persons who have a senior high school diploma or hold the educational equivalent, and who display a serious intent toward furthering their education.

School-Aged Dependents

Any school-aged dependants accompanying students to Australia may be required to pay full fees if they are enrolled in either a government or non-government school.
