

# INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2020



JMC Academy is pleased to present 3 streams of scholarship opportunities for international students in 2020. These partial tuition scholarships are worth up to AU\$18,000 each and will give students the opportunity to utilise their skills to contribute to the JMC Academy community.

**Scholarships are available for all Bachelor Degree applicants at any of our campuses in Brisbane, Sydney or Melbourne.**

- **Applicants must commence in June 2020.**
- **Applications close Friday 21st February 2020 at 5pm (AEDT).**
- **Students will be notified of outcomes by Monday 16th March 2020.**



## SCHOLARSHIP STREAMS

### FILM AND TELEVISION SCHOLARSHIP

*Amount: Up to \$18,000 over the duration of study, with \$3000 applied to each trimester.*

Recipients of the Film and Television Scholarship must enrol in a Bachelor of Creative Arts (Film & Television). The scholarship will be applied to each trimester of study, beginning with \$3000 for the first trimester. Continuation of the scholarship is dependent on the student satisfying the requirements each trimester.

#### Requirements:

1. The student will be required to create 2 x 1-minute high quality videos per trimester, documenting aspects of JMC Academy student life and activities. The International Services team will consult on the development of the videos.
2. The student must pass all units each trimester and produce videos that sufficiently match briefs in order to maintain the scholarship.

#### How to apply:

1. Submit your normal application for the Bachelor of Creative Arts (Film & Television) with all required documentation.
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from a Careers Advisor, High School Principal, High School teacher, employer or a JMC Academy representative student recruitment agent.
3. Submit a folio of 3-4 pieces of film work you have filmed and edited.

### STUDENT AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP

*Amount: Up to \$18,000 over the duration of study, with \$3000 applied to each trimester.*

Recipients of the Student Ambassador Scholarship may enrol in any JMC Academy bachelor degree. The scholarship will be applied to each trimester of study, beginning with \$3000 for the first trimester. Continuation of the scholarship is dependent on the student satisfying the requirements each trimester.

#### Requirements:

1. The student will be required to be an active member of the Student Representative Council and contribute to events held on and off campus. They will be guided by the International Services team and will be required to keep a log of all ambassador activities.
2. The student must pass all units each trimester and satisfy the other requirements of the Student Ambassador program (such as SRC and event participation) in order to maintain the scholarship for the following trimester.

#### How to apply:

1. Submit your normal bachelor degree application with all required documentation.
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from a Careers Advisor, High School Principal, High School teacher, employer or a JMC Academy representative student recruitment agent.
3. Submit your CV and/or information on any events you have helped organise.

### ONLINE AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP

*Amount: Up to \$18,000 over the duration of study, with \$3000 applied to each trimester.*

Recipients of the Online Ambassador Scholarship may enrol in any JMC Academy bachelor degree. The scholarship will be applied to each trimester of study, beginning with \$3000 for the first trimester. Continuation of the scholarship is dependent on the student satisfying the requirements each trimester.

#### Requirements:

1. The student will be required to create content for social media and the JMC Academy website. This will include a minimum of 2 social posts a week, one blog post per trimester and live social posting from at least 2 events per trimester.
2. The student must pass all units each trimester and satisfy the specific social media content production requirements of the scholarship in order to maintain the scholarship for the following trimester.

#### How to apply:

1. Submit your normal bachelor degree application with all required documentation.
2. Submit a letter of recommendation from a Careers Advisor, High School Principal, High School teacher, employer or a JMC Academy representative student recruitment agent.
3. Submit a sample of social media posts and/or any public social media handles and one writing sample (maximum 1000 words).

## GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for one of these scholarships applicants must:

1. Satisfy the normal entry requirements for admission to a JMC Academy bachelor degree. These include:
  - Be at least 18 years old at the time of commencement;
  - Evidence of successful completion of a senior secondary school certificate (submit a certified copy of high school transcripts, translated if not in English)
  - Evidence of minimum English language proficiency equivalent to Academic IELTS 6.0 (with no band below 5.5);
  - Interview
  - Animation/Games/Design applicants must submit a portfolio;
  - Performance/Songwriting applicants must submit an audition or folio.
2. Be a citizen of a country other than Australia or New Zealand.
3. Satisfy the criteria outlined in the specific scholarship you wish to apply for.

## SELECTION

- Selection will be based on a combination of academic merit; supporting files as requested in each individual stream; and an interview with a representative from the International Services team.
- The applicant will be responsible for ensuring that pending academic results are provided to JMC Academy immediately upon their release in order to be considered for a scholarship.
- JMC Academy reserves the right not to offer a scholarship if a candidate of suitable calibre does not apply.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Submit COMPLETE application for the relevant Bachelor degree by Friday 21st February 5pm (AEDT) to [international@jmc.edu.au](mailto:international@jmc.edu.au)
2. Submit a statement (250 words max) outlining which scholarship stream you wish to be considered for and why you should be selected.
3. Submit items relevant to the scholarship stream you are applying for (see 'how to apply' section under each stream).
4. Shortlisted applicants will be contacted for an online interview by 28th February.
5. Offers will be issued by 13th March.

## CONDITIONS

1. This award is applied to JMC Academy tuition only and may not be redeemed for cash or any other monetary exchange.
2. Students are required to pay the remaining tuition amount for each trimester before the commencement of the trimester.
3. In order to receive an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE) for visa application, students must pay the full remaining tuition amount for the first trimester of study.
4. Other fees associated with student travel and relocation (eg. flights, living expenses, Overseas Student Health Cover or consumables) are not covered by this award.
5. Students must commence study at JMC Academy in the June 2020 intake. All June 2020 students are required to be in Australia in time for Orientation week, which commences 25th May 2020.
6. While students may apply for more than one scholarship stream, they will be selected for one scholarship stream only. No further tuition discounts may apply.
7. Scholarships may only be deferred due to special circumstances, such as delay in visa issuance, and in that event only for a period of one trimester.

## FORFEIT OF SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships may be forfeited if, in the opinion of JMC Academy management and faculty, the scholarship recipient:

- Fails to abide by the conduct rules outlined in the JMC Academy Student Handbook;
- Resigns from their scholarship or discontinues studies at JMC Academy;
- Is found to be in breach of student visa conditions.
