TEMPORARY STAY Book short-term before you arrive so you can explore suburbs and arrange inspections.

PRIVATE RENTAL SHARE HOUSES

The most common long-term choice for JMC students. -Renting ("leasing") can be through an agent or privately.

You'll usually pay:

- Bond (security deposit) = 4 weeks rent
- Rent in advance = 4 weeks rent
- Most rentals are unfurnished check before signing.
- Inspect in person before signing and check travel time to campus.
