#### TEMPORARY STAY

Book short-term before you arrive so you can explore suburbs and arrange inspections.

- Hostels are budget-friendly and can be booked online
- Serviced apartments offer more comfort and privacy for short stays.

#### **HOMESTAY**

Live with a local family in a registered home — great for settling in and improving your English. Meals are often included. Suitable for younger students or those new to Australia. Some students stay for the whole course, others for a few months before moving out.

#### PRIVATE RENTAL SHARE HOUSES

The most common long-term choice for JMC students. -Renting ("leasing") can be through an agent or privately.

You'll usually pay:

- Bond (security deposit) = 4 weeks rent
- Rent in advance = 4 weeks rent
- Most rentals are unfurnished check before signing.
- Inspect in person before signing and check travel time to campus.


- · Book short-term first, then decide on long-term
