About Inholland University

[Inholland University of Applied Sciences](#), with campuses across the Netherlands, offers a variety of creative programs that complement the curriculum at JMC Academy. These programs, which include Arts and Design, Media and Entertainment, and Digital Innovation, provide practical, industry-aligned education similar to JMC's approach. Each year, Inholland hosts over 200 students from partner universities worldwide, allowing them to earn credits toward their degree and experience a different educational system, enriching their global outlook.

Pre-Requisites

This program is available for **Music Production, Contemporary Music Performance, Entertainment Business Management and Film and Television** students only.

Students must complete 3 trimesters at JMC Academy prior to the exchange.

Available Programs

- [Film \(The Hague\)](#): This course addresses the changing dynamic of the media landscape, teaching students to produce high-quality, distinctive content efficiently. Students will learn to evaluate creative ideas critically and navigate the globalized media market.
- [E- Music \(Haarlem\)](#): Focuses on electronic music production, performance, and media composition. Covers advanced studio work, music for film and games, and branding, preparing students for careers as producers, DJs, or media composers.
- [International Music Industry Lab \(Haarlem\)](#): Brings students together with leading industry partners to tackle real-world challenges in areas such as mental health, digital innovation, sustainability, diversity, and urban music ecosystems. Through collaborative projects, events, and coaching, students develop creative solutions, build professional networks, and gain hands-on experience in shaping the future of the music industry.
- [Pop Music \(Haarlem\)](#): This course develops student's musicianship and creative skills through individual coaching, collaborative ensemble projects, songwriting workshops, and live performances.

Tuition fees

JMC Academy students will continue to pay their normal tuition fees to JMC Academy for the trimester that they are on exchange. No further tuition fees are payable for the exchange program. Students are responsible for the cost of transportation, accommodation, passports, visa fees, travel insurance, meals, public transport, and other associated costs.

Financial Support

Students eligible for Youth Allowance can continue to receive the allowance while on the exchange. Find further information about receiving payments while outside Australia [here](#).

Living Costs

Students can expect general living expenses to amount to approximately €900-1,400 per month. This amount includes accommodation rental, food, transport and personal expenses. The program is approximately four months long.

Accommodation

There is a shortage when it comes to student housing in the Netherlands. Students should start arranging their accommodation as early as possible (at least four months in advance). The rent price for student accommodation in the Netherlands is between €500 and 900 per month. Most students in the Netherlands live in shared student housing.

Studying with Disabilities or Personal Circumstances

Inholland provides support for students with disabilities or personal circumstances. Early communication with the student counsellor is encouraged for tailored assistance and support.

Visas

Some students need a long-stay visa (MVV) and/or a residence permit (VVR). Inholland will apply for this on behalf of the student. Insurance

Insurance is mandatory for students who need an entry visa and/or residence permit (all non-EU Students).
