	Government VET Student Loan Debt) on the agreed dates and accept that						
	should I not make my payments on the due date; my place may be terminated,						
В	and I will forfeit my right to the AFTT qualification for the course. I accept that any						
	unpaid balance of fees will still remain due. Debt collection activities may include legal action and registering any default with a credit rating provider, and fees						
	over ninety (90) days late will incur charges. Debt recovery expenses will be paid						
	by the student.
