About Falmouth University

Falmouth University has been at the forefront of creative arts education in the UK for over a century. Known for its vibrant community and innovative approach, it offers robust academic programs aimed at developing the next generation of creative professionals.

The University is situated on two main campuses in Cornwall: the historic Falmouth Campus, and the Penryn Campus. More than 5 and a half thousand students from across the globe study here with staff and students working in professional standard environments which include state-of-the-art performance studios, some of the best photography facilities in Europe, cutting edge machinery at the Fashion and Textiles Institute and a TV studio and gallery within the School of Film & Television.

Pre-Requisites

This program is available for Contemporary Music Performance, Songwriting, Music Production, Acting, Music Theatre, Audio Engineering and Sound Production, Entertainment Business Management, Film and Television, Animation, Game Design and Design (Visual Communications) students. Students must have completed at least two trimesters of study at JMC Academy prior to commencing the exchange program.

Tuition fees

JMC Academy students will continue to pay their normal tuition fees to JMC Academy for the trimester that they are on exchange. No further tuition fees are payable for the exchange program.

Associated costs

All costs associated with travel, accommodation, living expenses, health insurance and other costs required for the stay at the host University will be assumed by the exchange student.

Financial Support

Students eligible for Youth Allowance can continue to receive the allowance while on the exchange. Find further information about receiving payments while outside Australia here.

Accommodation

Falmouth Accommodation Office may be able to arrange accommodation in the University's halls of residence, however campus housing for incoming exchange students is not guaranteed. Visas

To check your visa status, please take this survey on the Gov.uk website (https://www.gov.uk/check-uk-visa) and follow the guidance. This can change at any time, so please check this right before you intend to book travel. Some nationalities can stay in the UK as a student for up to 6 months without a visa but must meet the Standard Visitor eligibility requirements. If staying for longer, you will require a



Student Visa. Please check via the website.
